



Verium Solo Mining Setup Guide

Note : cpuminer-opt does not support getwork so won't work for solo mining, use <https://github.com/effectsToCause/veriumMiner>

Edit verium.conf to add:

```
server=1
daemon=1
rpcuser=veriumuser
rpcpassword=secret
rpcallowip=192.168.123.*
rpcallowip=172.16.0.*
rpcallowip=localhost
```

Replace the rpcallowip lines with ones that map to the ip address of your miners. If it's on the same machine then localhost covers it. * are wildcards that cover all the possible combinations, e.g. 192.168.123.* means 192.168.123.1 to 192.168.123.254 are all allowed.

Use the following commandline for the miner:

```
cpuminer -o 192.168.123.20:33987 -O veriumuser:secret
```

Where 192.168.123.20 is the IP of machine the wallet is running on, use 127.0.0.1 if its the same machine.

And you're mining!
